## AN ACT

To provide that crib bumpers shall be considered banned hazardous products under section 8 of the Consumer Product Safety Act, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Safe Cribs Act”.

3 **SEC. 2. BANNING OF CRIB BUMPERS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 180 days after the  
5 date of enactment of this Act, crib bumpers, regardless  
6 of the date of manufacture, shall be considered a banned  
7 hazardous product under section 8 of the Consumer Prod-  
8 uct Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2057).

9 (b) **CRIB BUMPER DEFINED.**—In this section, the  
10 term “crib bumper”—

11 (1) means any material that is intended to  
12 cover the sides of a crib to prevent injury to any crib  
13 occupant from impacts against the side of a crib or  
14 to prevent partial or complete access to any openings  
15 in the sides of a crib to prevent a crib occupant from  
16 getting any part of the body entrapped in any open-  
17 ing;

18 (2) includes a padded crib bumper, a supported  
19 and unsupported vinyl bumper guard, and vertical  
20 crib slat covers; and

1           (3) does not include a non-padded mesh crib  
2           liner.
