Mr. CORNYN (for himself and Mrs. FEINSTEIN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to authorize the debarment of certain registrants, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Debarment Enforce-
5 ment of Bad Actor Registrants Act of 2021” or the
6 “DEBAR Act of 2021”.

7 **SEC. 2. DEBARMENT OF CERTAIN REGISTRANTS.**

8 Section 304 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
9 U.S.C. 824) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

1 “(h) DEBARMENT OF CERTAIN REGISTRANTS.—The
2 Attorney General may issue an order to prohibit, condi-
3 tionally or unconditionally, and permanently or for such
4 period as the Attorney General may determine, any person
5 from being registered under this title to manufacture, dis-
6 tribute, or dispense a controlled substance or a list I chem-
7 ical, if the Attorney General finds that the person—

8 “(1) meets or has met any of the conditions for
9 suspension or revocation of registration under sub-
10 section (a); and

11 “(2) has a history of prior suspensions or rev-
12 ocations of registration.”.

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
