## A BILL

To prohibit the use of stimulus funds for signage indicating that a project is being carried out using those funds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Axe the Stimulus  
5 Plaques Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SIGNAGE.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, none of  
8 the funds made available under the American Recovery  
9 and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–5) may  
10 be used for signage to indicate that a particular project

1 is being carried out using funds made available under that  
2 Act.
