AN ACT

To extend the National Alzheimer's Project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “NAPA Reauthorization
3 Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROJECT.**

5 Section 2 of the National Alzheimer’s Project Act (42
6 U.S.C. 11225) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (c)—

8 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking “and co-
9 ordination of” and inserting “on, and coordina-
10 tion of,”;

11 (B) in paragraph (4)—

12 (i) by redesignating subparagraphs
13 (A) and (B) as subparagraphs (B) and
14 (C), respectively; and

15 (ii) by inserting before subparagraph
16 (B), as so redesignated, the following:

17 “(A) promotion of healthy aging and re-
18 duction and mitigation of risk factors for Alz-
19 heimer’s;”;

20 (C) in paragraph (5)—

21 (i) by inserting “and other under-
22 served populations, including individuals
23 with developmental disabilities such as
24 Down syndrome,” after “populations”; and

25 (ii) by striking “; and” and inserting
26 a semicolon;

1 (D) by redesignating paragraph (6) as
2 paragraph (7); and

3 (E) by inserting after paragraph (5) the
4 following:

5 “(6) provide information on, and promote the
6 adoption of, healthy behaviors that may reduce the
7 risk of cognitive decline and promote and protect
8 cognitive health; and”;

9 (2) in subsection (d)(2)—

10 (A) by inserting “, across public and pri-
11 vate sectors,” after “Nation’s progress”; and

12 (B) by inserting “, including consideration
13 of public-private collaborations, as appropriate”
14 before the period;

15 (3) in subsection (e)—

16 (A) in paragraph (2)—

17 (i) in subparagraph (A), by adding at
18 the end the following:

19 “(xi) A designee of the Department of
20 Justice.

21 “(xii) A designee of the Federal
22 Emergency Management Agency.

23 “(xiii) A designee of the Social Secu-
24 rity Administration.

1 “(xiv) 2 or more other designees, as
2 determined by the Secretary of Health and
3 Human Services, at least one of whom has
4 expertise in risk factors associated with the
5 development or the progression of Alz-
6 heimer’s.”; and

7 (ii) in subparagraph (B)—

8 (I) in the matter preceding clause
9 (i), by striking “12” and inserting
10 “15”;

11 (II) in clause (v)—

12 (aa) by striking “2 research-
13 ers” and inserting “3 research-
14 ers”; and

15 (bb) by striking “; and” and
16 inserting “, including at least one
17 researcher with demonstrated ex-
18 perience in recruitment and re-
19 tention of underrepresented
20 groups into research or clinical
21 trials related to dementia;”;

22 (III) in clause (vi), by striking
23 the period and inserting a semicolon;
24 and

1 (IV) by adding at the end the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(vii) 1 individual with a diagnosis of
4 Alzheimer’s disease; and

5 “(viii) 1 representative from a histori-
6 cally underserved population whose lifetime
7 risk for developing Alzheimer’s is markedly
8 higher than that of other populations.”;

9 (B) in paragraph (5)—

10 (i) in subparagraph (A)—

11 (I) by striking “an initial evalua-
12 tion” and inserting “annual evalua-
13 tions”; and

14 (II) by striking “research, clin-
15 ical” and inserting “research, risk re-
16 duction, public health, clinical”;

17 (ii) in subparagraph (B), by striking
18 “initial”;

19 (iii) in subparagraph (C)—

20 (I) in the matter preceding clause
21 (i), by striking “initial”; and

22 (II) in clause (ii), by inserting
23 “and reduce disparities” before the
24 semicolon; and

- 1 (iv) in subparagraph (D), by striking
2 “annually thereafter, an evaluation” and
3 inserting “annual evaluations”; and
4 (C) in paragraph (6), by striking “2025”
5 and inserting “2035”;
- 6 (4) in subsection (g)—
- 7 (A) in paragraph (1)—
- 8 (i) by adding “and” after the semi-
9 colon;
- 10 (ii) by striking “that includes an eval-
11 uation” and inserting “that includes—
12 “(A) an evaluation;”; and
- 13 (iii) by adding at the end the fol-
14 lowing:
- 15 “(B) a summary of the Secretary’s process
16 for identifying and updating what conditions
17 constitute Alzheimer’s disease;”; and
- 18 (B) in paragraph (3)(A)(ii), by inserting
19 “and reduce disparities” before the semicolon;
20 and

1 (5) in subsection (h), by striking “2025” and
2 inserting “2035”.
