Mr. HELLER (for himself, Mr. BURR, Mr. VITTER, and Mr. BOOZMAN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

- To provide that Members of Congress may not receive pay after October 1 of any fiscal year in which Congress has not approved a concurrent resolution on the budget.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "No Budget, No Pay5 Act".

6 SEC. 2. DEFINITION.

7 In this section, the term "Member of Congress"—

- 8 (1) has the meaning given under section 2106
- 9 of title 5, United States Code; and

(2) does not include the Vice President. SEC. 3. TIMELY APPROVAL OF CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ON THE BUDGET.

4 If both Houses of Congress have not approved a con-5 current resolution on the budget as described under section 301 of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment 6 7 Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 632) for a fiscal year before 8 October 1 of that fiscal year, the pay of each Member of 9 Congress may not be paid for each day following that Oc-10 tober 1 until the date on which both Houses of Congress approve a concurrent resolution on the budget for that fis-11 12 cal year.

13 SEC. 4. NO PAY WITHOUT CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ON 14 THE BUDGET.

15 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds may be appropriated or otherwise 16 be made available from the United States Treasury for 17 the pay of any Member of Congress during any period de-18 19 termined by the Chairperson of the Committee on the 20 Budget of the Senate or the Chairperson of the Committee 21 on the Budget of the House of Representatives under sec-22 tion 5.

(b) NO RETROACTIVE PAY.—A Member of Congress
may not receive pay for any period determined by the
Chairperson of the Committee on the Budget of the Sen-

ate or the Chairperson of the Committee on the Budget
 of the House of Representatives under section 5, at any
 time after the end of that period.

4 SEC. 5. DETERMINATIONS.

5 (a) Senate.—

6 (1) REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATIONS.—On Octo-7 ber 1 of each year, the Secretary of the Senate shall 8 submit a request to the Chairperson of the Com-9 mittee on the Budget of the Senate for certification 10 of determinations made under paragraph (2) (A) 11 and (B).

12 (2) DETERMINATIONS.—The Chairperson of the
13 Committee on the Budget of the Senate shall—

14 (A) on October 1 of each year, make a de15 termination of whether Congress is in compli16 ance with section 4 and whether Senators may
17 not be paid under that section; and

(B) determine the period of days following
each October 1 that Senators may not be paid
under section 4; and

(C) provide timely certification of the determinations under subparagraphs (A) and (B)
upon the request of the Secretary of the Senate.
(b) HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.—

1	(1) Request for certifications.—On Octo-
2	ber 1 of each year, the Chief Administrative Officer
3	of the House of Representatives shall submit a re-
4	quest to the Chairperson of the Committee on the
5	Budget of the House of Representatives for certifi-
6	cation of determinations made under paragraph (2)
7	(A) and (B).
8	(2) DETERMINATIONS.—The Chairperson of the
9	Committee on the Budget of the House of Rep-
10	resentatives shall—
11	(A) on October 1 of each year, make a de-
12	termination of whether Congress is in compli-
13	ance with section 4 and whether Senators may
14	not be paid under that section; and
15	(B) determine the period of days following
16	each October 1 that Senators may not be paid
17	under section 4; and
18	(C) provide timely certification of the de-
19	terminations under subparagraph (A) and (B)
20	upon the request of the Chief Administrative
21	Officer of the House of Representatives.
22	SEC. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.
23	This section shall take effect on February 1, 2013.
