## A BILL

To prevent the Secretary of the Treasury from expanding United States bank reporting requirements with respect to interest on deposits paid to nonresident aliens.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON TREASURY REGULATIONS
- 4 WITH RESPECT TO INFORMATION REPORT-
- 5 ING ON CERTAIN INTEREST PAID TO NON-
- 6 RESIDENT ALIENS.
- 7 Except to the extent provided in Treasury Regula-
- 8 tions as in effect on February 21, 2011, the Secretary of
- 9 the Treasury shall not require (by regulation or otherwise)

1	that an information return be made by a payor of interest
2	in the case of interest—
3	(1) which is described in section $871(i)(2)(A)$ of
4	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and
5	(2) which is paid—
6	(A) to a nonresident alien, and
7	(B) on a deposit maintained at an office
8	within the United States.
