A BILL

To block any action from being taken to finalize or give effect to a certain proposed rule governing the Federal child support enforcement program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON TAKING ANY ACTION TO FI-**
4 **NALIZE OR GIVE EFFECT TO CERTAIN PRO-**
5 **POSED RULE GOVERNING THE FEDERAL**
6 **CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
8 retary of Health and Human Services may not take any
9 action to finalize, implement, enforce, or otherwise give ef-
10 fect to the proposed rule, entitled “Flexibility, Efficiency,

1 and Modernization in Child Support Enforcement Pro-
2 grams” (79 Fed. Reg. 68548–68587, November 17,
3 2014), or any proposal set forth in the proposed rule.

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
