Mr. BENNETT (for himself and Mr. HATCH) introduced the following bill;  
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Nat-  
ural Resources

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## A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of certain parcels of land  
to the town of Mantua, Utah.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Box Elder Utah Land  
5       Conveyance Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE.**

7       (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

8               (1) MAP.—The term “map” means the map en-  
9       titled “Box Elder Utah Land Conveyance Act” and  
10       dated July 14, 2008.

1           (2) NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LAND.—The  
2 term “National Forest System land” means the par-  
3 cels of National Forest System land that—

4           (A) are located in—

5                 (i) sec. 27, T. 9 N., R. 1 W., Salt  
6 Lake meridian; and

7                 (ii) the Wasatch-Cache National For-  
8 est in Box Elder County, Utah;

9           (B) consist of approximately 31.5 acres;

10           and

11           (C) are depicted on the map as parcels A,  
12 B, and C.

13           (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means  
14 the Secretary of Agriculture.

15           (4) TOWN.—The term “Town” means the town  
16 of Mantua, Utah.

17           (b) CONVEYANCE.—As soon as practicable after the  
18 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall convey  
19 to the Town, without consideration and by quitclaim deed,  
20 all right, title, and interest of the United States in and  
21 to the National Forest System land.

22           (c) SURVEY.—

23                 (1) IN GENERAL.—If determined by the Sec-  
24 retary to be necessary, the exact acreage and legal  
25 description of the National Forest System land shall

1 be determined by a survey approved by the Sec-  
2 retary.

3 (2) COST.—The Town shall pay each cost aris-  
4 ing from a survey described in paragraph (1).

5 (d) USE OF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LAND.—As  
6 a condition of the conveyance under subsection (b), the  
7 Town shall use the National Forest System land only for  
8 public purposes.

9 (e) REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—In the quitclaim  
10 deed to the Town, the Secretary shall provide that the Na-  
11 tional Forest System land shall revert to the Secretary,  
12 at the election of the Secretary, if the National Forest  
13 System land is used for a purpose other than a public pur-  
14 pose.

15 (f) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—With re-  
16 spect to the conveyance under subsection (b), the Sec-  
17 retary may require such additional terms and conditions  
18 as the Secretary determines to be appropriate to protect  
19 the interests of the United States.

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
