**A BILL**

To amend the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 to reauthorize the Judicial Conference of the United States to redact sensitive information contained in financial disclosure reports of judicial officers and employees, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REDACTION AUTHORITY CONCERNING SEN-**  
2 **SITIVE SECURITY INFORMATION.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 105(b)(3) of the Ethics  
4 in Government Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.) is amended  
5 by striking subparagraph (E).

6 (b) **TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.**—Section 105(b)(1)  
7 of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.)  
8 is amended—

9 (1) in the first sentence, by striking the second  
10 comma after “as the case may be”; and

11 (2) in the third sentence, by inserting a comma  
12 after “as the case may be”.
