3 SECTION 1. MUCK SOILS CONSERVATION.

Chapter 5 of subtitle D of title XII of the Food Security Act of 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3839bb et seq.) is amended
by adding at the end the following:

1 "SEC. 1240S. MUCK SOILS CONSERVATION.

2	"(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary shall carry
3	out a conservation program (referred to in this section as
4	the 'program') under which the Secretary shall make pay-
5	ments to assist owners and operators of eligible land speci-
6	fied in subsection (b) to conserve and improve the soil,
7	water, and wildlife resources of the land.
8	"(b) ELIGIBLE LAND.—To be eligible for inclusion
9	in the program, the land shall—
10	"(1) be comprised of soil that qualifies as
11	muck, as determined by the Secretary;
12	((2) be used for production of an agricultural
13	crop;
14	"(3) have a spring cover crop planted in con-
15	junction with the primary agricultural crop referred
16	to in paragraph (2);
17	"(4) have a winter crop planted; and
18	"(5) have ditch banks seeded with grass that is
19	maintained on a year-round basis.
20	"(c) PAYMENT AMOUNTS.—The Secretary may pro-
21	vide payments of not less than \$300, but not more than
22	\$500, per acre per year under the program.
23	"(d) Authorization of Appropriations.—There
24	is authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to carry

- 1~ out the program 50,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2012~
- 2 and 2013.".
