- 7 (a) In General.—The following Acts, and the
- 8 amendments made by such Acts, are repealed:
- 9 (1) The Patient Protection and Affordable Care
- 10 Act (Public Law 111–148).
- 11 (2) The Health Care and Education Reconcili-
- 12 ation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152).

- 1 (b) Effect of Law.—The provisions of law amend-
- 2 ed by the Acts referred to in subsection (a) are restored

3 as if such Acts had never been enacted.

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
