A BILL

- To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of the archeological site and surrounding land of the New Philadelphia town site in the State of Illinois, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "New Philadelphia, Illi-3 nois, Study Act".

4 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

- 5 Congress finds that—
- 6 (1) Frank MeWhorter, an enslaved man, bought
 7 his freedom and the freedom of 15 family members
 8 by mining for crude niter in Kentucky caves and
 9 processing the mined material into saltpeter;
- 10 (2) New Philadelphia, founded in 1836 by
 11 Frank McWhorter, was the first town established by
 12 a free African-American before the Civil War;
- 13 (3) the first railroad constructed in the area of
 14 New Philadelphia bypassed New Philadelphia, which
 15 led to the decline of New Philadelphia; and
- 16 (4) the New Philadelphia site—
 - (A) is covered by farmland; and
- 18 (B) does not contain any original buildings
 19 of the town or the McWhorter farm and home
- 20 that are visible above ground.

21 SEC. 3 2. DEFINITIONS.

6 subsection (a) shall be conducted in accordance with sec7 tion 8 of Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5).

8 (d) REPORT.—Not later than 3 years after the date 9 on which funds are first made available for the study 10 under subsection (a), the Secretary shall submit to the 11 Committee on Natural Resources of the House of Rep-12 resentatives and the Committee on Energy and Natural 13 Resources of the Senate a report containing—

14 (1) the results of the study; and

15 (2) any conclusions and recommendations of the16 Secretary.
