A BILL

To require that the face of Federal Reserve Notes bear the likeness of Jeannette Rankin before the likeness of any other woman appears on a Federal Reserve Note, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Celebrating the First
5 Woman in Congress Currency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIKENESS OF JEANNETTE RANKIN REQUIRED TO**
2 **BE INCLUDED ON THE FACE OF FEDERAL RE-**
3 **SERVE NOTES.**

4 The eighth undesignated paragraph of section 16 of
5 the Federal Reserve Act (12 U.S.C. 418) is amended by
6 adding at the end the following new sentence: “Beginning
7 on the date of enactment of this Act, if the Secretary of
8 the Treasury determines that the face of one of the fore-
9 going denominations shall bear the likeness of a woman,
10 the face of any Federal Reserve Note may not bear the
11 likeness of any other woman until after the date on which
12 Federal Reserve Notes bearing the likeness of Jeannette
13 Rankin are first printed.”.

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
