A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of certain parcels of land to the town of Alta, Utah.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	$tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled,$
3	SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE.
4	(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:
5	(1) NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LAND.—The
6	term "National Forest System land" means the par-
7	cels of National Forest System land that—
8	(A) are located—
9	(i) in sec. 5, T. 3 S., R. 3 E., Salt
10	Lake meridian;

1	(ii) in, and adjacent to, parcels of
2	land subject to special use permit
3	SLC102708, the authority of which expires
4	on December 30, 2026;
5	(iii) in the Wasatch-Cache National
6	Forest in Salt Lake County, Utah; and
7	(iv) in the incorporated boundary of
8	the town of Alta, Utah; and
9	(B) consist of approximately 2 acres (in-
10	cluding appurtenances).
11	(2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
12	the Secretary of Agriculture.
13	(3) Town.—The term "Town" means the town
14	of Alta, Utah.
15	(b) Conveyance.—As soon as practicable after the
16	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall convey
17	to the Town, without consideration, all right, title, and in-
18	terest of the United States in and to the National Forest
19	System land.
20	(c) Survey.—
21	(1) In General.—In accordance with para-
22	graphs (2) and (3), the exact acreage and legal de-
23	scription of the National Forest System land shall
24	be determined by a survey approved by the Sec-
25	retary.

1	(2) Maximum area.—The acreage of the Na-
2	tional Forest System land determined under para-
3	graph (1) may not exceed 2 acres.

- 4 (3) Cost.—The Town shall pay each cost aris-5 ing from a survey described in paragraph (1).
- 6 (d) USE OF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LAND.—As
 7 a condition of the conveyance under subsection (b), the
 8 Town shall use the National Forest System land only for
 9 public purposes.
- 10 (e) REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—In the deed to the 11 Town, the Secretary shall provide that the National Forest 12 System land shall revert to the Secretary, at the election 13 of the Secretary based on the best interests of the United 14 States, if the National Forest System land is used for a 15 purpose other than a public purpose.
- 16 (f) Additional Terms and Conditions.—With re-17 spect to the conveyance under subsection (b), the Sec-18 retary may require such additional terms and conditions 19 as the Secretary determines to be appropriate to protect 20 the interests of the United States.
