A BILL

To amend the Chesapeake Bay Initiative Act of 1998 to provide for the reauthorization of the Chesapeake Bay Gateways and Watertrails Network.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Chesapeake Bay Gate-
5 ways and Watertrails Network Reauthorization Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 Section 502(c) of the Chesapeake Bay Initiative Act
3 of 1998 (16 U.S.C. 461 note; Public Law 105–312) is
4 amended by striking “fiscal years” and all that follows
5 through the period at the end and inserting “fiscal years
6 2012 through 2016.”.
