3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Currency Evolution

5 Now To Save Act" or the "CENTS Act".

6 SEC. 2. METAL COMPOSITION OF CERTAIN COINS.

7 Section 5112(b) of title 31, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) by inserting "(1)" after "(b)"; and

1	(2) by adding at the end the following:
2	((2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) , the Secretary
3	may prescribe a composition of materials in, and a con-
4	struction of, the half dollar, quarter dollar, dime, or 5-
5	cent coin that varies from the composition and construc-
6	tion required under that paragraph with respect to the
7	coin (including by using different metals in the alloy for
8	the coin than those required under that paragraph) if that
9	action by the Secretary—
10	"(A) reduces the overall cost of minting the
11	coin; and
12	"(B) does not affect—
13	"(i) the diameter and weight of the coin
14	specified under subsection (a); or
15	"(ii) the functionality of the coin, including
16	the electromagnetic signature with respect to
17	the acceptance of the coin.".
