## A BILL

To eliminate the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection by repealing title X of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, commonly known as the Consumer Financial Protection Act of 2010.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Repeal CFPB Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

6 The Consumer Financial Protection Act of 2010 (12  
7 U.S.C. 5481 et seq.) is repealed, and the provisions of law

- 1 amended or repealed by that Act are restored or revived
- 2 as if the Act had not been enacted.
