## A BILL

To amend the Foreign Aid Transparency and Accountability Act of 2016 to require the information on the ForeignAssistance.gov website to be searchable.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foreign Aid Trans-  
5 parency and Accountability Enhancement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF MATTERS TO BE MADE PUB-**  
2 **LICLY AVAILABLE.**

3 Section 4(b)(1) of the Foreign Aid Transparency and  
4 Accountability Act of 2016 (22 U.S.C. 2394c(b)(1)) is  
5 amended to read as follows:

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The information described  
7 in subsection (a)—

8 “(A) shall be published on a detailed basis,  
9 such as award-by-award; and

10 “(B) shall include, and shall be searchable  
11 by—

12 “(i) country or region, as appropriate;

13 “(ii) funding agency;

14 “(iii) managing agency;

15 “(iv) sector;

16 “(v) total award amount;

17 “(vi) appropriations account;

18 “(vii) fiscal year or fiscal years; and

19 “(viii) implementing partners, includ-  
20 ing prime and subawards.”.
