3 **SECTION 1. RULEMAKING REQUIREMENT.**

4 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment
5 of this Act, the Administrator of the Federal Motor Car-
6 rier Safety Administration and the Administrator of the
7 Federal Railroad Administration shall complete the rule-
8 making process and publish a final rule regarding the ad-
