## A BILL

To prohibit the provision of Federal funds to an entity that receives compensation for facilitating the donation of fetal tissue derived from an abortion.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON FUNDING.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
5 sion of law, no Federal funds shall be made available to  
6 any affiliate, subsidiary, successor, or clinic of the Planned  
7 Parenthood Federation of America, Inc., if that affiliate,  
8 subsidiary, successor, or clinic receives compensation for

1 facilitating the donation of fetal tissue products derived  
2 from an abortion.

3 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act  
4 shall be construed to—

5 (1) affect any limitation contained in an appro-  
6 priations Act relating to abortion; or

7 (2) reduce overall Federal funding available in  
8 support of women’s health.

9 (c) INVESTIGATION AND REPORT.—Not later than 90  
10 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Attorney  
11 General shall conduct an investigation, and submit to Con-  
12 gress a report on the findings of such investigation, con-  
13 cerning whether or not the Planned Parenthood Federa-  
14 tion of America, Inc., or any of its affiliates, subsidiaries,  
15 successors, or clinics has engaged in any illegal activity  
16 pertaining to fetal tissue products.
