3 **SECTION 1. PROVIDING COVERAGE FOR WIGS AS DURABLE**
4 **MEDICAL EQUIPMENT UNDER THE MEDI-**
5 **CARE PROGRAM.**

6 Section 1861(n) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7 1395x(n)) is amended by adding at the end the following
8 new sentence: “Such term also includes cranial prostheses
9 furnished to an individual, but only where the dermatolo-

1 gist, oncologist, or attending physician of the individual
2 certifies in writing the medical necessity of such pros-
3 theses as part of a proposed course of rehabilitative treat-
4 ment.”.

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
