- 6 SEC. 2. REINSTATEMENT OF FEDERAL MATCHING OF
- 7 STATE SPENDING OF CHILD SUPPORT INCEN-
- 8 TIVE PAYMENTS.
- 9 Effective October 1, 2010, section 455(a)(1) of the
- 10 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 655(a)(1)) is amended by
