Mr. CARDIN (for himself and Mr. BOOZMAN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize a Wall of Remembrance as part of the Korean War Veterans Memorial and to allow certain private contributions to fund the Wall of Remembrance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Korean War Veterans
5 Memorial Wall of Remembrance Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. WALL OF REMEMBRANCE.**

7 Public Law 99–572 (40 U.S.C. 8903 note; 100 Stat.
8 3226) is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 **“SEC. 4. WALL OF REMEMBRANCE.**

2 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The memorial authorized
3 under section 1 shall include a Wall of Remembrance.

4 “(b) NO FEDERAL FUNDS.—Federal funds may not
5 be used to construct the Wall of Remembrance.

6 “(c) DESIGN RECOMMENDATIONS.—The American
7 Battle Monuments Commission shall request and consider
8 design recommendations from the Korean War Veterans
9 Memorial Foundation, Inc., for the establishment of the
10 Wall of Remembrance.

11 “(d) REQUIREMENTS.—The Wall of Remembrance
12 shall include—

13 “(1) a list by name of members of the Armed
14 Forces of the United States who died in theater in
15 the Korean War;

16 “(2) the number of members of the Armed
17 Forces of the United States who, in regards to the
18 Korean War—

19 “(A) were wounded in action;

20 “(B) are listed as missing in action; or

21 “(C) were prisoners of war; and

22 “(3) the number of members of the Korean
23 Augmentation to the United States Army, the Re-
24 public of Korea Armed Forces, and the other na-
25 tions of the United Nations Command who, in re-
26 gards to the Korean War—

- 1 “(A) were killed in action;
- 2 “(B) were wounded in action;
- 3 “(C) are listed as missing in action; or
- 4 “(D) were prisoners of war.”.
