Ms. STABENOW (for herself and Mr. PETERS) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize the award of the Medal of Honor to James
C. McCloughan for acts of valor during the Vietnam War.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR AWARD OF THE MEDAL**
4 **OF HONOR TO JAMES C. MCCLOUGHAN FOR**
5 **ACTS OF VALOR DURING THE VIETNAM WAR.**

6 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Notwithstanding the time lim-
7 itations specified in section 3744 of title 10, United States
8 Code, or any other time limitation with respect to the
9 awarding of certain medals to persons who served in the
10 Armed Forces, the President may award the Medal of

1 Honor under section 3741 of such title to James C.
2 McCloughan for the acts of valor during the Vietnam War
3 described in subsection (b).

4 (b) ACTS OF VALOR DESCRIBED.—The acts of valor
5 referred to in subsection (a) are the actions of James C.
6 McCloughan during combat operations of May 13–15,
7 1969, during the Battle for Nui Yon Hill, for which he
8 was previously awarded the Bronze Star Medal with “V”
9 Device.

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
