Mr. MARKEY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To provide that any termination of a director of a national research institute or national center of the National Institutes of Health be on the basis of malfeasance, neglect of office, or incapacity only.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Institutes of
5 Health Director Protection Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF DIRECTORS OF THE NATIONAL RE-**
2 **SEARCH INSTITUTE OR NATIONAL CENTER**
3 **OF THE NIH.**

4 Section 405(a)(2)(E) of the Public Health Service
5 Act (42 U.S.C. 284(a)(2)(E)) is amended—

6 (1) in the subparagraph heading, by striking
7 “RULE OF CONSTRUCTION” and inserting “TERMI-
8 NATION FOR CAUSE”; and

9 (2) by inserting “, except that any such termi-
10 nation may be made only on the basis of malfea-
11 sance by, neglect of office by, or incapacity of the di-
12 rector” before the period.

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
