- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Energy is au7 thorized to make \$150,000,000 available to carry out the
  8 American centrifuge project research, development, and

demonstration program of the Department of Energy, to
 remain available until expended, of which—

3 (1) \$44,000,000 shall be derived from proceeds
4 from the disposition of reenriched uranium from ex5 isting uranium owned by the Department of Energy;
6 and

7 (2) \$106,000,000 shall be derived from unobli8 gated balances of funds made available to carry out
9 other programs and activities of the Department.

10 (b) REPORTS.—The Secretary of Energy shall submit 11 to the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate, the 12 Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representa-13 tives, the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources 14 of the Senate, and the Committee on Energy and Com-15 merce of the House of Representatives quarterly reports 16 on the progress of the program described in subsection 17 (a).
