Mr. SULLIVAN (for himself and Mr. SCOTT of Florida) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To require the Secretary of Defense to deliver on foreign military sales to Taiwan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DELIVERY ON FOREIGN MILITARY SALES TO**
4 **TAIWAN.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), with re-
6 spect to defense articles and services contracted to be sold
7 to Taiwan under the foreign military sales process as of
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
9 Defense, with the concurrence of the Government of Tai-
10 wan, shall ensure the delivery of such defense articles and

1 services to Taiwan ahead of the delivery of substantially
2 similar articles and services to any other foreign military
3 sales customer.

4 (b) LIMITATION.—The Secretary of Defense may not
5 apply subsection (a) in a manner that, directly or indi-
6 rectly, inhibits or delays the delivery of substantially simi-
7 lar articles and services to Ukraine or Israel.
