A BILL

To adjust the definition of service in the uniformed services with respect to readmission requirements for servicemembers under the Higher Education Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Servicemember Enroll-
5 ment and Readmission for Valuable Education Act” or the
6 “SERVE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. READMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR**
2 **SERVICEMEMBERS.**

3 Section 484C(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
4 (20 U.S.C. 1091c(a)) is amended to read as follows:

5 “(a) **DEFINITION OF SERVICE IN THE UNIFORMED**
6 **SERVICES.**—In this section, the term ‘service in the uni-
7 formed services’ means service (whether voluntary or in-
8 voluntary) on active duty in the Armed Forces, including
9 such service by a member of the National Guard or Re-
10 serve on active duty, active duty for training, or National
11 Guard duty under State order or Federal authority.”.
