A BILL

To modify the boundary of the Fort Scott National Historic Site in the State of Kansas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fort Scott National
5 Historic Site Boundary Modification Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FORT SCOTT NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Public Law 95–484 (92 Stat.
3 1610) is amended—

4 (1) in the first section—

5 (A) by inserting “or by purchase with ap-
6 propriated funds” after “donation”; and

7 (B) by striking the proviso; and

8 (2) in section 2—

9 (A) by striking “**SEC. 2.** When” and in-
10 serting the following:

11 **“SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT.**

12 “(a) IN GENERAL.—When”; and

13 (B) by adding at the end the following:

14 “(b) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—The boundary of
15 the Fort Scott National Historic Site established under
16 subsection (a) is modified as generally depicted on the
17 map referred to as ‘Fort Scott National Historic Site Pro-
18 posed Boundary Modification’, numbered 471/80,057, and
19 dated ~~June 2015~~ *February 2016*.”.

20 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
21 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as are nec-
22 essary to carry out the amendments made by subsection
23 (a).
