## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain power panels specifically designed for wind turbine generators to transfer electric power to and from a utility power grid at 2100 kW at 600 volts with a nominal full load of 2190 amps.

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN POWER PANELS SPECIFICALLY DE-**  
 2 **SIGNED FOR WIND TURBINE GENERATORS**  
 3 **TO TRANSFER ELECTRIC POWER TO AND**  
 4 **FROM A UTILITY POWER GRID AT 2100 KW AT**  
 5 **600 VOLTS WITH A NOMINAL FULL LOAD OF**  
 6 **2190 AMPS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
 8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
 9 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
 10 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Power panels specifically designed for wind turbine generators in excess of 2 MW; such panels designed to transfer electric power to and from a utility power grid at 2100 kW at 600 volts with a nominal full load of 2190 amps; with dimensions of 2350–2450 mm (length) x 550–650 mm (width) x 2200–2350 mm (height); and with a display system that monitors at a minimum wind speed, yaw position, and blade pitch angle (provided for in subheading 8537.10.90) ..... 11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 12 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 13 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
 14 the date of the enactment of this Act.
