1SEC. 2. ALLOWING ABOVE-THE-LINE DEDUCTIONS FOR2CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS FOR INDIVID-3UALS NOT ITEMIZING DEDUCTIONS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 62 of the
5 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by inserting
6 after paragraph (21) the following new paragraph:

7 "(22) CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS FOR INDI-8 VIDUALS NOT ITEMIZING DEDUCTIONS.—In the case 9 of an individual who does not elect to itemize his de-10 ductions for the taxable year, the deduction allowed by section 170. The preceding sentence shall not 11 12 apply to any deduction in excess of an amount equal 13 to the product of $\frac{1}{3}$ and the standard deduction for 14 such individual.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
this section shall apply with respect to taxable years beginning after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
