3 SECTION 1. O-ANISIDINE.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.10.41 of the Har5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 o-Anisidine) is amended by striking "12/31/2009" and in7 serting "12/31/2011".

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
10 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

1 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of

2 this Act.
