3 SECTION 1. BENZOIC ACID, 3,4,5-TRIHYDROXY-, PROPYL 4 ESTER.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.34 of the Har6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 Benzoic acid, 3,4,5-trihydroxy-, propyl ester) is amended
8 by striking "12/31/2009" and inserting "12/31/2011".

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by10 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of
 this Act.
