A BILL

To limit the level of premium subsidy provided by the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation to agricultural producers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON PAYMENT OF PORTION OF**
4 **PREMIUM BY CORPORATION.**

5 Section 508(e) of the Federal Crop Insurance Act (7
6 U.S.C. 1508(e)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(9) LIMITATION.—

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any
2 other provision of this title, the total amount of
3 premium paid by the Corporation on behalf of
4 a person or legal entity, directly or indirectly,
5 with respect to all policies issued to the person
6 or legal entity under this title for a crop year
7 shall be limited to a maximum of \$70,000.

8 “(B) RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER LAW.—To
9 the maximum extent practicable, the Corpora-
10 tion shall carry out this paragraph in accord-
11 ance with section 1001 of the Food Security
12 Act of 1985 (7 U.S.C. 1308).”.

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
