## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain ice cream  
makers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ICE CREAM MAKERS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Ice cream makers with motors of at least 50 watts but not more than 60 watts each with a bowl capacity of 1.4 liters or more but not more than 1.95 liters (provided for in subheading 8509.40.00) ...	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
