Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain educational toys or devices.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL TOYS OR DEVICES.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 9902.85.43 of the  
5       Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating  
6       to certain educational toys or devices) is amended—

7               (1) by striking “0.55%” and inserting “Free”;  
8       and

9               (2) in the effective period column, by striking  
10       “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
