To amend title 5, United States Code, to exempt the Internal Revenue Service from certain labor-management relations requirements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End the Partisan IRS
5 Culture Act” or the “EPIC Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS; APPLICATION.**

7 Section 7103(a)(3) of title 5, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (G), by striking “or” at
10 the end;

1 (2) in subparagraph (H), by striking the period
2 at the end and inserting “; or”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(I) the Internal Revenue Service.”.
