A BILL

To prevent homeowners from being forced to pay taxes on forgiven mortgage loan debt.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mortgage Forgiveness
5 Tax Relief Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF EXCLUSION FROM GROSS INCOME**
7 **OF DISCHARGE OF QUALIFIED PRINCIPAL**
8 **RESIDENCE INDEBTEDNESS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (E) of section
10 108(a)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amend-

1 ed by striking “January 1, 2013” and inserting “January
2 1, 2015”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
4 this section shall apply to indebtedness discharged after
5 December 31, 2012.
