A BILL

To provide for the discharge of parent borrower liability if a student on whose behalf a parent has received certain student loans becomes disabled.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as “Domenic’s Law”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPAYMENT OF LOANS TO PARENTS.**

6 Section 437(d) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
7 (20 U.S.C. 1087(d)) is amended by inserting “or becomes
8 permanently and totally disabled (as determined in accord-
9 ance with regulations of the Secretary), or if the student

1 is unable to engage in any substantial gainful activity by
2 reason of any medically determinable physical or mental
3 impairment that can be expected to result in death, has
4 lasted for a continuous period of not less than 60 months,
5 or can be expected to last for a continuous period of not
6 less than 60 months,” after “dies,”.

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
