1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. PIGMENT GREEN 7 CRUDE.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.20 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
Pigment Green 7 Crude) is amended by striking the date
in the effective column period and inserting "12/31/2011".
(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by

9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- $2 \ \ {\rm the \ date \ of \ the \ enactment \ of \ this \ Act.}$
