- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN MANUFACTURING EQUIPMENT.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.84.81 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 certain manufacturing equipment) is amended by striking
- 7 the date in the effective column period and inserting "12/
- 8 31/2011".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
