## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on yarn of carded cashmere of 19.35 metric yarn count or higher.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. YARN OF CARDED CASHMERE OF 19.35 METRIC
4 YARN COUNT OR HIGHER.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.02 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
yarn of carded cashmere of 19.35 metric yarn count or
higher) is amended by striking the date in the effective
period column and inserting "12/31/2015".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
