Mr. HELLER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To prohibit the further extension or establishment of national monuments in the State of Nevada except by express authorization of Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Nevada Land Sov-
5 ereignty Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ESTAB-**
2 **LISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN**
3 **THE STATE OF NEVADA.**

4 The proviso of the last sentence of the first section
5 of the Act of September 14, 1950 (64 Stat. 849, chapter
6 950; 16 U.S.C. 431a), is amended by inserting “or Ne-
7 vada” after “Wyoming”.

8 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON ENFORCEMENT OF SECRETARIAL**
9 **ORDER NO. 3310 IN NEVADA WITHOUT CON-**
10 **GRESSIONAL APPROVAL.**

11 Except by express authorization of Congress, the Sec-
12 retary of the Interior shall not implement, administer, or
13 enforce Secretarial Order No. 3310, issued by the Sec-
14 retary of the Interior on December 22, 2010.

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
