Mr. LUJÁN (for himself and Mr. HEINRICH) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry

A BILL

To provide additional funds to States for administration of certain nutrition programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Nutrition Administra-
5 tion Assistance Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.**

7 (a) COMMODITY SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM.—

8 In addition to amounts otherwise made available to State
9 agencies to pay administrative costs incurred by State
10 agencies to carry out section 5 of the Agriculture and Con-

1 sumer Protection Act of 1973 (7 U.S.C. 612c note; Public
 2 Law 93–86), 70 percent of the amounts authorized to be
 3 appropriated under section 3 shall be provided for those
 4 administrative costs.

5 (b) STATE PLANS UNDER THE EMERGENCY FOOD
 6 ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1983.—In addition to amounts oth-
 7 erwise made available to States to pay administrative costs
 8 incurred by States to carry out State plans under section
 9 202A of the Emergency Food Assistance Act of 1983 (7
 10 U.S.C. 7503), 20 percent of the amounts authorized to
 11 be appropriated under section 3 shall be provided for those
 12 administrative costs.

13 (c) SENIORS FARMERS’ MARKET NUTRITION PRO-
 14 GRAM.—In addition to amounts otherwise made available
 15 to the Secretary of Agriculture for administrative costs to
 16 carry out section 4402 of the Farm Security and Rural
 17 Investment Act of 2002 (7 U.S.C. 3007), 10 percent of
 18 the amounts authorized to be appropriated under section
 19 3 shall be provided for those administrative costs.

20 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

21 There is authorized to be appropriated to carry out
 22 this Act \$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2024 through
 23 2028.
