A BILL

To amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to include a prohibition on the listing of a living nonnative species as a threatened species or an endangered species, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Saving America’s Vul-
5 nerable and Endangered Species Act” or the “SAVES
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON LISTING OF LIVING NONNATIVE**
 2 **SPECIES AS THREATENED SPECIES OR EN-**
 3 **DANGERED SPECIES.**

4 (a) **LIMITATION.**—The Endangered Species Act of
 5 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.) is amended by adding at
 6 the end the following:

7 **“SEC. 19. PROHIBITION ON LISTING OF LIVING NONNATIVE**
 8 **SPECIES AS THREATENED SPECIES OR EN-**
 9 **DANGERED SPECIES.**

10 “Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
 11 retary shall not list under section 4(c) any living nonnative
 12 species.”.

13 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—The table of con-
 14 tents for the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C.
 15 prec. 1531) is amended by inserting after the item relating
 16 to section 17 the following:

“Sec. 18. Annual cost analysis by the Fish and Wildlife Service.

“Sec. 19. Prohibition on listing of living nonnative species as threatened species
 or endangered species.”.
