A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on sports footwear for persons other than men (other than ski-boots, cross-country ski footwear and snowboard boots), valued \$12/pair or higher, with spikes.

1 **SECTION 1. SPORTS FOOTWEAR FOR PERSONS OTHER**
 2 **THAN MEN (OTHER THAN SKI-BOOTS, CROSS-**
 3 **COUNTRY SKI FOOTWEAR AND SNOWBOARD**
 4 **BOOTS), VALUED \$12/PAIR OR HIGHER, WITH**
 5 **SPIKES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
 7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
 8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
 9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Sports footwear for persons other than men (other than ski-boots, cross-country ski footwear and snowboard boots), valued \$12/pair or higher, with spikes (provided for in subheading 6402.19.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 11 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 12 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 13 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
