A BILL

To permit the Secretary of Homeland Security to search open source information to determine if an alien is inadmissible to the United States and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “21st Century Visa Vet-
5 ting Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO SEARCH OPEN SOURCE INFORMA-**
2 **TION RELATED TO ALIENS APPLYING FOR**
3 **ADMISSION TO THE UNITED STATES.**

4 (a) **AUTHORITY.**—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law or regulation, the Secretary of Homeland Secu-
6 rity may search open source information, including Inter-
7 net sites and social media postings, of an alien who applies
8 for a visa to enter the United States to determine if the
9 alien is inadmissible under section 212 of the Immigration
10 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182).

11 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—This section shall take effect
12 on the date of the enactment of this Act and apply to any
13 alien who applies for a visa on or after that date.

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
