## A BILL

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3 SECTION 1. PIGMENT PREPARATIONS BASED ON CERIUM** 

4 SULFIDE OR MIXTURES OF CERIUM SULFIDE
5 AND LANTHANUM SULFIDE.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.90 of the Har-

7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

8 cerium sulfide pigments) is amended—

(1) by striking the article description and in serting the following: "Pigment preparations based
 on cerium sulfide or mixtures of cerium sulfide and
 lanthanum sulfide (provided for in subheading
 3206.49.60)"; and

6 (2) by striking "12/31/2009" and inserting
7 "12/31/2011".

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
