1 **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OF TETRAKIS(HYDROXYMETHYL)**
 2 **PHOSPHONIUM CHLORIDE, POLYMER WITH**
 3 **UREA, TETRAKIS(HYDROXYMETHYL)**
 4 **PHOSPHONIUM CHLORIDE, FORMALDEHYDE,**
 5 **AND WATER/INERTS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
 7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
 8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
 9 new heading:
