- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN MEN'S FOOTWEAR, VALUED OVER \$23/
- 4 PAIR, NOT COVERING THE ANKLE, WITH A
- 5 COATED OR LAMINATED TEXTILE FABRIC.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.61 of the Har-
- 7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 8 certain men's footwear, valued over \$23/pair, not covering

- 1 the ankle, with a coated or laminated textile fabric) is
- 2 amended—
- 3 (1) by striking "\$20/pair" and inserting "\$23/
- 4 pair"; and
- 5 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
- 6 column and inserting "12/31/2011".
- 7 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 8 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 9 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 10 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
